This workshop will go in depth about phonics and the other components of early literacy recommended by the National Reading Panel, the neuroscience behind early literacy, how to provide a systematic, explicit approach to teaching phonics, and how to assess specifically what a young student may need. Participants can expect:

- Explanation of the Big Five and how they are related to each other
- Neuroscience of early literacy-the deeper science of phonics and reading
- Going beyond a screener to recognize the specific stage of a student's learning and then plan appropriate next steps in instruction and remediation
- How to plan a systematic, sequential scope and sequence of phonics instruction
- Guidance in building a beginning lesson
