

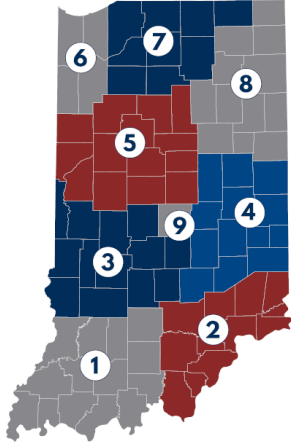
## Guardrails to Greenlights: A District Playbook for AI Policy & Planning with Pete Just

This workshop provides practical guidance on setting the right guardrails for safety, compliance, and trust - while also identifying the greenlights where districts can responsibly accelerate innovation.

We will build on the language and structure of the Consortium for School Networking (CoSN) [Generative AI Maturity Tool](#), Teach AI's [AI Guidance for Schools Toolkit](#), and Digital Promise's [AI Literacy Framework](#) to help participants understand the “why” behind AI adoption and apply it to their own district’s operational and instructional realities.

This event is considered “hybrid.” You will join a room of school staff from districts across our region to engage in activities and discussions guided by an on-site facilitator. Meanwhile, the presenter will participate virtually, sharing their expertise and leading coordinated activities with multiple locations across Indiana.
